8	\$4,269	\$5,355	\$7,240	Up to \$1,164

\*If a household's income is high, the household is more likely to qualify if they pay for housing costs.

## Households

A household is defined as an individual, couple, family or group that <u>purchase and prepare food</u> together. Household members do not need to be related.

People who must apply together regardless of purchasing and preparing food separately:

- A married couple who live together
- Children under 22 living with parent(s)
- Unmarried couple living together with a common child

## Possible Income Deductions Include:

- Housing Costs
  Utilities
  Child Support Payments
- Child-Care Costs
  Medical Costs (only for Seniors/Disabled)
